KTEC serves as a Professional Development School for Carthage College's Education Program. Dr. Prisca Moore, Professor of Education at Carthage, teaches her Science and Math Methods courses on-site at KTEC. Pre-service students then support and teach a variety of STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering, Math) lessons in KTEC classrooms. This provides mutual development in both programs. Carthage has developed and instructs KTEC students in aquaponics, vermicomposting, hydroponics, gardening activities and experiments. (carthage.edu)
