KENOSHA, WI: Kenosha School of Technology Enhanced Curriculum’s (KTEC) students have been asked to demonstrate the hands-on projects they complete as part of PLTW’s elementary and middle-school curriculum. Students will spend the day presenting in the rotunda, as well as join Lieutenant Governor Rebecca Kleefisch in a discussion about STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering, Math) education.

PLTW Day at the Capital, April 5th, is part of a statewide celebration of the impact Project Lead the Way has on its schools, students, teachers, and economy during the week of April 3-7, 2017, which Governor Scott Walker has officially proclaimed as “Project Lead the Way Week.”

KTEC has been a PLTW school since it opened its doors in 2007. The school has two PLTW Master Teachers, piloted the Launch program, PLTW’s elementary curriculum, and regularly hosts PLTW Showcase days sharing the program with educators from around the state.
